

# I.T.C. Practical Nursing

## (1-2 Years)

Learning outcomes can be evidenced in any of the following ways:

- Credit from formal coursework earned in the ISU Practical Nursing program.
- Transfer credit for equivalent transcribed coursework earned at a regionally accredited institution of higher education.
- Credit from formal coursework earned in the ISU Practical Nursing program by completing modules of instruction that address deficiencies between the military experience of a specific veteran and the desired learning outcomes of the program.
- Credit through equivalent military service and coursework as documented on military educational transcripts.
- Credit through experiential learning assessment which requires the creation of a portfolio by the student.
- Credit by challenge examination (limited to a 24 credits maximum).

Credit for prior learning is limited to a maximum of 50 percent of the total credits of the certificate, with differential limits being assigned to the various types of prior learning. A minimum of 16 resident credit hours must be completed at ISU. Please note, "When the credit awarded is dependent upon evaluation by Idaho State University faculty, such as Experiential Learning Assessment or Challenge Examination, credit will be counted as resident credit."
